To the Hawaii Air Tour Noise & Safety Task Force

The Hawai'i Kai Neighborhood Board is writing to confirm its strong support for the better regulation of tour helicopters and low flying aircraft that frequently disrupt the residential areas of East Honolulu. Our concern for this issue has been long standing.

I have attached a copy of a letter dated November 15, 2018, urging cooperation between the Federal Aviation Administration and the Hawaii State Department of Transportation to work together to mitigate the many concerns of our community on this issue. Also attached is a formal resolution from the Hawaii Kai Neighborhood Board, dated June 25, 2019, requesting federal, state and county officials to address the need for increased regulations governing tour helicopters and other small aircraft over O'ahu.

As this issue remains a significant concern to the East Honolulu community, and little progress appears to have been made since our concerns were first communicated, the Hawaii Kai Neighborhood Board has again acted to unanimously approve a motion at its regularly scheduled meeting of October 27, 2020, to urge the Federal Aviation Administration and the Hawai'i State Department of Transportation to work together, and with the affected communities, to develop solutions to better regulate low flying tour helicopters and small aircraft over East Honolulu residential areas.

We would be pleased to be part of a problem-solving process to seek solutions. Thank you for your consideration of our concerns and comments.
