



Statewide Rotor and Fixed Wing System Plan Update With Focus on Action Items from the Hawaii Air Tour & Safety Task Force Meetings

APRIL 20, 2021

Purpose

- In response to noise and safety concerns identified by the Hawaii Air Noise and Safety Task Force, a **Special Study** that focuses on meaningful action items to address key issues primarily stemming from Rotor and Fixed Wing Tour Operators should be developed.
- The “**Special Study**” will be conducted in advance of the **Statewide GA System Plan Update**
 - Per the FAA Advisory Circular 150/5070-7: *The Airport System Planning Process* (Chapter 7), a “Special Study” can be undertaken:
 - To analyze new issues or further address unique situations or problems that were identified during the basic airport system planning process
 - Be exploratory or involve a new approach to an old problem
 - Support decisions on airport roles and result in sound recommendations for developing a system of airports within a specific jurisdiction
 - The Special Study is funded by FAA.
 - It will take into account prior studies and current initiatives.
